Summary of the 14th ASEA-UNINET Plenary Meeting

The 14th ASEA-UNINET Plenary Meeting was held on 13 - 17 July 2014 in Innsbruck / Austria at the *Grand Hotel Europa*. The Meeting was organized by the *ASEA-UNINET office Innsbruck* with the support of the *ASEA-UNINET office Vienna*. Nearly 100 participants from Thailand, Malaysia, The Philippines, Vietnam, Pakistan, Indonesia, Italy, Germany, Slovakia, Austria as well as several guests of honour attended the meeting.

Sunday, 13.7.2014

The participants of the 14th ASEA-UNINET Plenary Meeting arrived in Innsbruck during the day until the late evening. After the check-in at the hotel and the registration at the ASEA-UNINET registration-desk all participants were cordially invited to a welcome-dinner hosted by ASEA-UNINET at the Grand Hotel Europa.

Monday, 14.7.2014 (morning)

The Plenary Meeting started with an official Opening Ceremony in the Baroque Hall of the Grand Hotel Europa, where the meeting mainly took place. Monday, 14.7.2014 (evening)

After the elections the focus group discussions started. The subjects followed the four focus areas of cooperation within ASEA-UNINET:

Science and Technology
Economic and Social Sciences
Health, Pharmacy and Medicine
Humanities, Culture and Music

Tuesday, 15.7.2014 (evening)

The social event this evening was an excursion to *Swarovski Crystal Worlds* in *Wattens*. After visiting the *14 Chambers of Wonder* all conference participants were invited to a dinner hosted by Swarovski Company.

Wednesday, 16.7.2014 (morning)

The third day of the Plenary Meeting started with the continuation of the focus group discussions. After that all participants appeared in the Baroque Hall of the Grand Hotel Europa in order to discuss the regulations of ASEA-UNINET. The following two amendments were decided – both unanimously:

- 1) Membership and enrolment fees will increase by Euro 100,-/Year
- 2) Limit of travel support will be increased from Euro 1.300,- to Euro 1.400,-

Afterwards other important decisions were made:

- 1) The next ASEA-UNINET Plenary Meeting will take place in Indonesia in early 2016.
- 2) Following an invitation from Professor Ludomír Šlahor (Vice-Rector for International Relations of Comenius University in Bratislava) the next National Coordinator meeting will take place in Slovakia in 2015.

Wednesday, 16.7.2014 (afternoon)

The afternoon session was dedicated to the results of the focus groups discussions. The Focus Groups *Humanities, Culture and Music* and *Economics and Social Science* were combined, and hence three presentations were given. Links are listed below:
