PROGRAM TITLE:

ASEA-UNINET International Community Outreach Program: Stunting Prevention Acceleration

A. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The International Community Outreach Program is a one-week program designed to offer participants a once-in-a-lifetime experience that allows them to explore and respond to the actual social life issues, and assist the community to overcome problems. Adapting the 1st – End Poverty and the 3rd – Good Health and Well-being – of Sustainable Development Goals, this year's program has a theme about Stunting Prevention Acceleration. It is as part of a response to target 1.3 and 3.2 - implements nationally appropriate social protection systems and measures for all, including floors, and by 2030 achieve substantial coverage of the poor and the vulnerable; and by 2030, end preventable deaths of newborns and children under 5 years of age, with all countries aiming to reduce neonatal mortality to at least as low as 12 per 1,000 live births and under-5 mortality to at least as low as 25 per 1,000 live births.

After a successful event last year in Surabaya and Sidoarjo, the program will be held in Surabaya and Semarang by conducting a collaboration between Universitas Airlangga and Universitas Diponegoro under the ASEA-UNINET consortium in which generates this program entitled ASEA-UNINET International Community Outreach Program: Stunting Prevention Acceleration.

The aim of ASEA-UNINET International Community Outreach Program 2020: Stunting Prevention Acceleration is to bridge and optimize the role of academia, both students and researchers, in stunting prevention. The direct interaction with the community and the gathering of experts on these fields are expected to have an impact on the emerging of new ideas and collaborations that can support and accelerate the decreasing of stunting rate.

B. PROJECTED COLLABORATION

Universitas Airlangga and Universitas Diponegoro collaborate to conduct the ASEA-UNINET International Community Outreach Program: Stunting Prevention Acceleration.



C. PROPOSED LOCATION

The proposed location of the ASEA-UNINET International Community Outreach Program 2020: Stunting Prevention Acceleration is decided by considering the collaboration between Universitas Airlangga and Universitas Diponegoro as follows:

2. Semarang

D. MECHANISM AND PROGRAM DESIGN

In accordance with the theme and objective, this program is designed in such way that could encourage participants to observe and interact with the community directly as well as gather many information, therefore the ideas and research plan will be more focus on problem solving and will be conducted right on target.

This program will consist of four main activities carried out in Surabaya and Semarang. The first activity is workshop that aims to provide an overview of conditions related to stunting in general. The second is site visit as the main activity in exploring and understanding the actual conditions in community related to stunting and its derivative issues; participants are also expected to do community service activity such as conducting socialization and counseling. The third activity is group projects that consist of focus group discussions and presentation concerning all the findings and issues that are found after hands-on activities with the communities. The fourth activity is joint research meeting by faculty members and lecturer participants to generate potential research collaborations.
